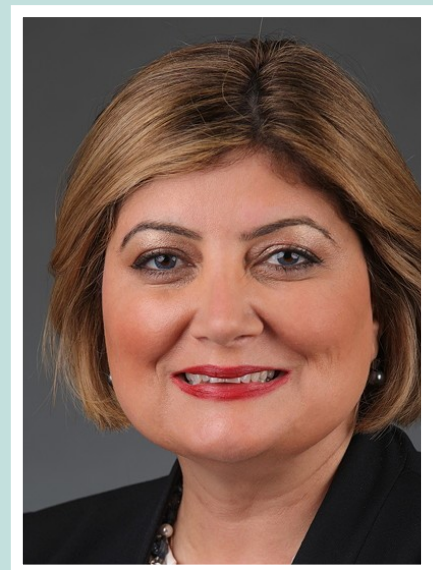

Inquiry into Responses to Historical Forced Adoption in Victoria

We are delighted and honored to have Natalie Suleyman MP as Guest Speaker at our 33rd AGM.

Natalie Suleyman MP was elected to the Victorian Parliament in 2014, as the Member for St Albans in Melbourne's West. Ms Suleyman is the daughter of Turkish Cypriot migrants, and the first Muslim female to be elected to the Parliament of Victoria. In 2019, Ms Suleyman was appointed Chair of the Legislative Assembly Legal and Social Issues Committee. She has chaired inquiries into Early Childhood Engagement of CALD Communities, Anti-Vilification Protections, and most recently, Responses to Historical Forced Adoption in Victoria.

We look forward to hearing Ms Suleyman speak and share her insights about the Parliamentary Inquiry into Responses to Historical Forced Adoption in Victoria.
